

Happy Holidays, Show Secretaries!

I wanted to make you aware of some very important information and changes for the 2015 Show Season.

- All Top Ten shows must be received in the NRHA office 90 days prior to the entry closing date. Any changes to added money, entry fees, or retainage that is changed within 90 days will cause the show to NO longer count as a Top Ten show.
- AA and A Level Events now only require the approval to be in 90 days prior to the entry closing date.
- Aged Shows are now eligible to offer a Level 4 Open OR a Level 4 Non Pro and are no longer required to have both.
- Exhibitors are no longer allowed to show with a General Membership. General
 memberships are good for Owners and Nominators. If you are planning on showing in an
 Open class, you must have a Professional, a Non Pro, or a Youth membership. An
 Associate membership is still acceptable for Category 10 classes only.
- Immediate Family has now been extended to aunt, uncle, grandmother and grandfather.
 This applies for all ages
- Members may now renew online, because of this there will be a new \$30 rush fee to all memberships that are being done at shows (exception, new members).
- Show Results, in their entirety, are to be postmarked 10 business days after the completion of the event. After the 10 days, there will be a fine and may jeopardize future approvals.
